- 2-16 MGD water treated

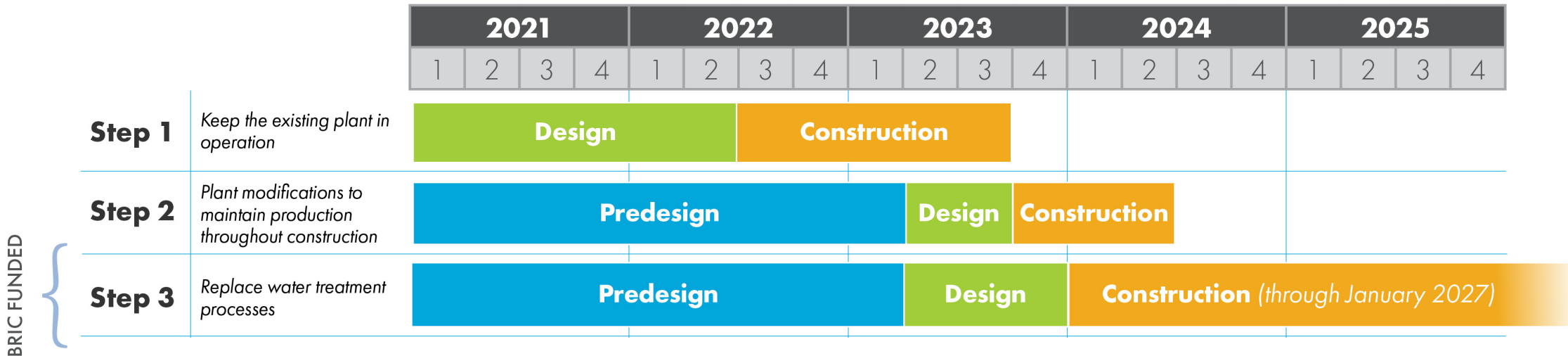










- Purpose
 - Upgrade existing treatment plant and improve resiliency.
- Funding
 - FEMA BRIC Grant
 - \$36.7 million
 - Reduce cost to rate-payers by approx. 30%

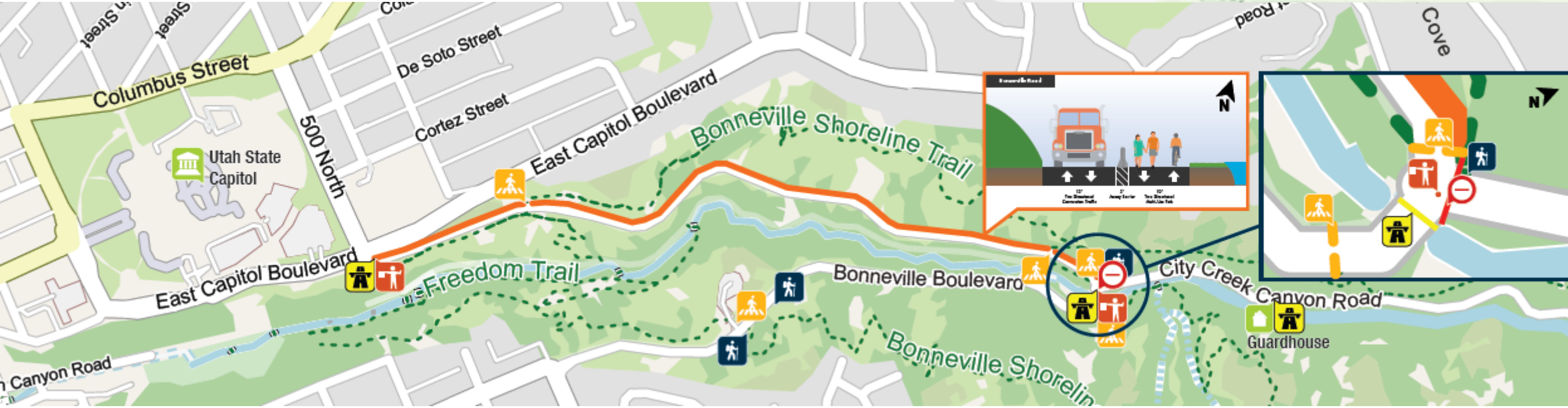


Project Schedule



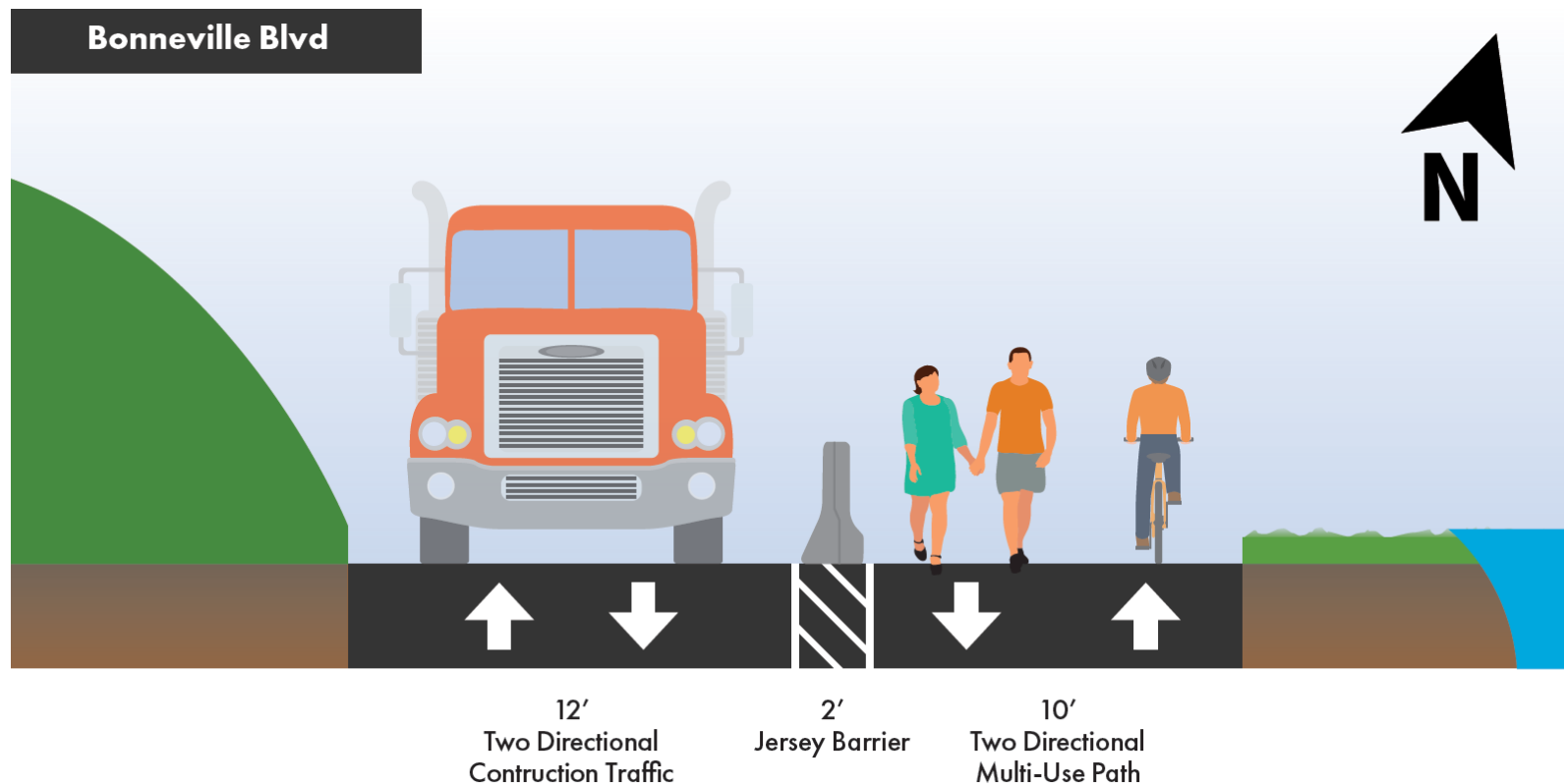

Canyon Closures – Bonneville Blvd.

- Heavy Construction Traffic / Delays
- Barrier Separating Pedestrians and Vehicles
- Trail Access Maintained



Canyon Usage

- City Creek Canyon Road
 - Closures begin Nov. 1, 2023
 - Roadway above Bonneville Blvd.
 - OPEN weekends and holidays
 - Bikes and pedestrians only
 - CLOSED Monday-Friday
 - Roadway above Site 16 closed for the duration of the project



Canyon Restrictions

- Trails
 - Bonneville Shoreline Trail – OPEN
 - All other trails
 - CLOSED beyond Site 6
- No Water or Facilities available

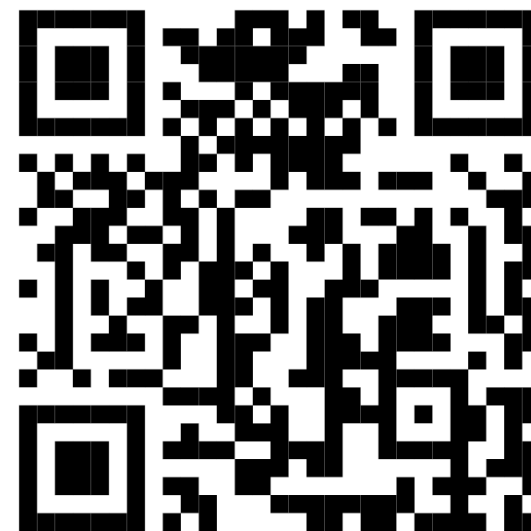
